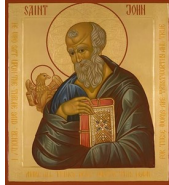

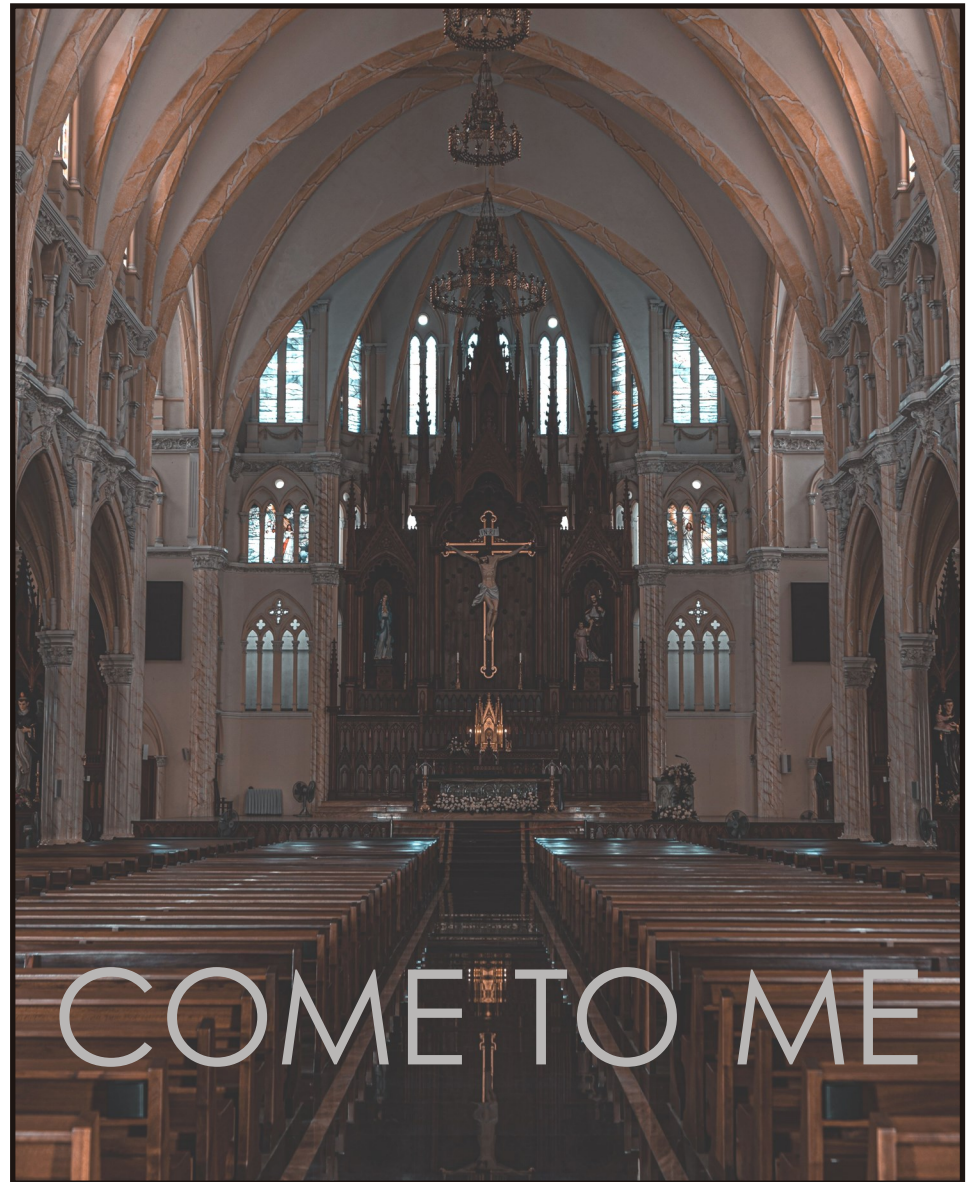

## Dear Parish Families of Holy Family and St. John,







## 125<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY HISTORY OF OUR PARISH

### THE FOURTH HISTORICAL INSTALLMENT

Rev. Francis Kruk was appointed pastor on December 5, 1935. A capable administrator, he tackled the parish's heavy debt, deteriorating buildings, and depleted treasury. Before returning to Homestead in 1937, he reduced the debt, began needed repairs, and restored the church's finances.

In April 1937, Rev. Brislaus E. Mierunski assumed leadership of the parish. His optimism, generosity, and strong interest in Latrobe's youth quickly earned him the trust and affection of parishioners, as well as the respect of the broader community. Under his guidance, the parish grew into a close-knit and effective congregation that advanced steadily. The parish debt paid off, and both the church and rectory were repaired and remodeled.

After 20 years, the school reopened under the Felician Sisters, serving 108 children in grades 1 through 8. The parish grew to 200 families. Father Mierunski also organized the Holy Name Society and revived the nearly extinct Sodality of the Blessed Virgin. His 25 years at St. John the Evangelist honored its past and strengthened confidence in its future

## 125<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY MASS & DINNER
