125TH ANNIVERSARY HISTORY OF OUR PARISH

FROM NOW UNTIL OCTOBER, WE WILL HIGHLIGHT THE HISTORY OF SAINT JOHN IN OUR BULLETIN! FOLLOW ALONG AND LEARN SOMETHING NEW!

Rev. Daniel C. Mahoney was assigned pastor of Saint John in June 1986. During his six years, many new programs and activities were developed. The Pastoral Council was reconstructed to include a system of committees. Workshops were established to develop a broader understanding of council members' leadership roles, and training sessions focused on the vision of the parish. Under his guidance, a "Liturgical Renewal" was brought forth following the Second Vatican Council. Under his guidance a Liturgical Committee, trained lectors, cantors, and Eucharistic ministers were incorporated into Sunday worship. The choir and entire congregation were challenged to full participation of the church in the Mass. The Ministry of Care began along the Eucharistic Ministers to the Sick.
