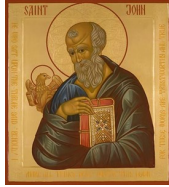

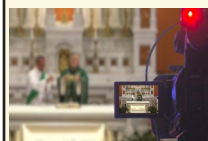

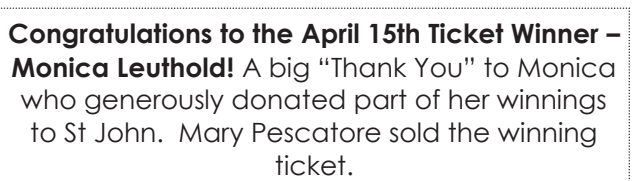

**OCIA** Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God." (Mt 5:9) How applicable this beatitude is to our present day. It tells us how much God desires all of his creation to live in peace.



## Why We Should Go to Confession

Confession, a sacred sacrament in the Catholic tradition, offers a profound opportunity for introspection, growth, and spiritual renewal.
